#### **GUARANTEE**

This CLARKE product is guaranteed against faulty manufacture for a period of 12 months from the date of purchase. Please keep your receipt as proof of purchase.

This guarantee is invalid if the product is found to have been abused or tampered with in any way, or not used for the purpose for which it was intended.

Faulty goods should be returned to their place of purchase, no product can be returned to us without prior permission.

This guarantee does not effect your statutory rights.

## SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

#### **IMPORTANT**

Failure to follow these precautions could result in personal injury, and/or damage to property.

- ALWAYS wear approved impact resistant safety goggles. (Eye glasses are NOT safety glasses).
- ALWAYS disconnect the tool when not in use, before changing accessories and before carrying out any maintenance
- 3. ALWAYS have trigger in the OFF position when connecting to an air supply.
- ALWAYS keep a safe distance between yourself and other people when using the tool.
- Maintain the tool with care. Keep it clean for best and safest performance.
- 6. Quick change couplings should not be located at the tool. They add weight and

could fail due to vibration.

- DO NOT over-reach. Keep your proper footing and balance at all times.
- DO NOT force or misuse the tool. It will do a better and safer job at the rate for which it was designed.
- 9. DO NOT abuse hoses or connectors. NEVER carry a tool by the hose, or yank it to disconnect from the air supply. Keep hoses away from heat, oil and sharp edges. Check hoses for weak or worn condition before use, and ensure that all connections are secure.
- 10. DO NOT exceed 90 PSI at the tool.
- 11. DO NOT modify the tool in any way

### **AIR SUPPLY**


Tools of this type, operate on a wide range of air pressures. It is recommended that air pressure to this tool does not exceed 70 PSI, at the tool when running. Higher pressure and unclean air, will shorten the tools' life because of faster wear, and could be a safety hazard.

Water in the air line will cause damage to the tool, ensure it is properly maintained at all times.

The recommended procedure to connect this tool to an air supply, is shown at fig. 1.

The air inlet used for connecting air supply,

has a standard ¼" BSP thread.



Line pressure, or hose inside diameter, should be increased to compensate for unusually long air hoses (over 25 feet). Minimum hose diameter should be 5/16" (8mm) ID., and fittings should have the same inside dimen.sions.

## **OPERATION**

Ensure the air supply is disconnected before filling the grease chamber.

- 1. Remove the end cap from the gun.
- 2. Drop the cartridge, containing the caulking medium into the tube.
- 3. Thread the end cap over the cartridge nozzle and screw back on to the gun firmly.
- 4. Ensure the end of the nozzle is cut off, preferably at an angle experience will determine the ideal angle, and ammount of nozzle to cut off, for the job in hand.
- 5. Connect the air supply, turn ON and approach the work. Press the trigger so that caulking medium is ejected. To stop, release the trigger. Be aware that medium will continue to be ejected for a short period until pressure drops. You should make allowances for this.

## **MAINTENANCE**

### **Daily**

- 1. Before use, drain water from air tank, air line and compressor.
- 2. If no line Lubricator is used, ensure that oil is applied to the tool (see below).

#### Weekly

Clean the air inlet filter.

#### **IMPORTANT**

Run a few drops of oil through the tool. It may be entered into the tool air inlet, ensuring the strainer is clear, or into the hose at the nearest connection to the air supply. Then run the tool. Clarke Air Line oil is available from your Clarke dealer or a rust inhibitive oil, available from auto supply stores etc., is acceptable.

Be aware that factors other than the tool may effect its operation and efficiency, such as reduced compressor output, excessive drain on the airline, moisture or restrictions in the line, or the use of connectors of improper size or poor condition which will reduce air supply. Grit or gum deposits in the tool may also reduce efficiency. This condition can be corrected by cleaning the air strainer and flushing out the tool with gum solvent oil, or failing this, the tool should be disassembled, thoroughly cleaned, dried and re-assembled.

Keep the tool clean at all times,


